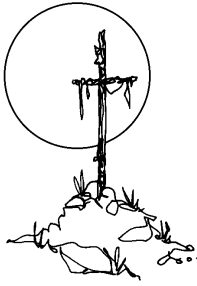

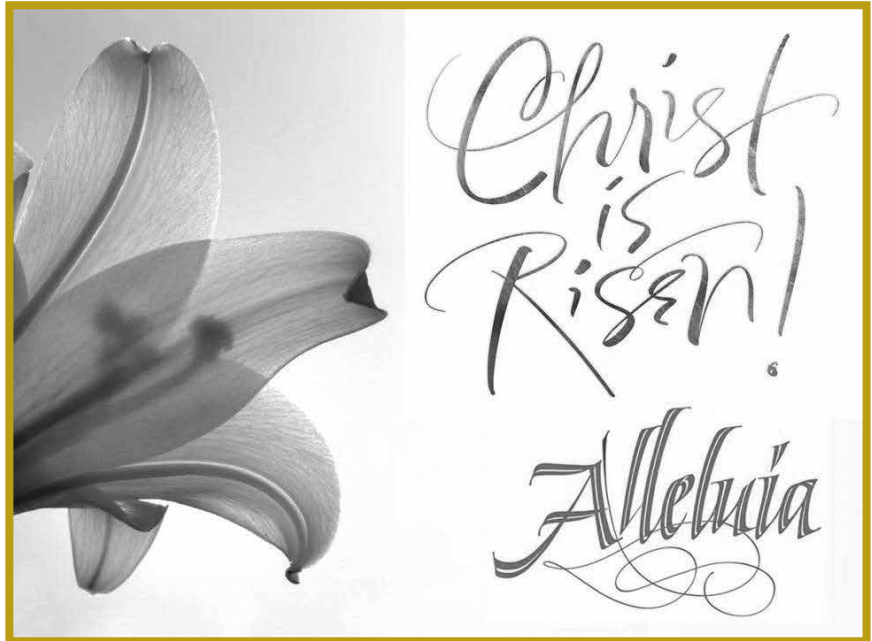
Catholic Charities Clinical Counseling
